The new triple drum mower KUH N PZ 960

KUHN presents the new PZ 960 triple drum mower, the latest generation of PZ 900 drum mowers.

The right and left rear mowing units on the PZ 960 are identical to those of the PZ 320, so the PZ 960 triple mower has a choice of working widths of 8.40 m, 8.65 m or 8.95 m and its cutting height can be adjusted continuously without the need for tools.

Weighing only 1900 kg, the PZ 960 is light, which means you can increase yield. Combined with the front-mounted PZ 320 F mower it provides the ideal solution for small and medium-sized farms with 100 to 150 hp tractors.

A multifunctional hydraulic control which lets you fold the left and right rear units separately, is fitted to the PZ 960 as standard.

The PZ 960 drum mower meets all your requirements and expectations relative to:

- **Performance:** with the unique combination of two large-diameter outer drums and two small-diameter inner drums.
- **Comfort:** the front and side covers are hinged so they can be folded back, which makes it easier to access the drums. Blades can be removed in just a few minutes, quickly and without the need for tools.
- **Safety:** with its hydro-pneumatic LIFT-CONTROL® suspension, the mowing unit shifts rearwards when it encounters an obstacle. The two outer drums are protected by FlexProtect covers. Because the cover is made of highly elastic plastic, it can be deformed without damaging the mowing unit or breaking when it meets an obstacle. After being deformed, the plastic springs back to its initial shape.
- **Long life:** with its modular design and standard equipment, the mowing unit is particularly easy to service. All wear parts can easily be replaced.
